**OFFICIAL CALL FOR THE 102<sup>nd</sup> ANNUAL CONVENTION  
AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY  
DEPARTMENT OF TEXAS  
AUSTIN, TEXAS – JULY 14-17, 2022**

In accordance with the Department Constitution and Bylaws, I, Teresa Simmons-Copeland, hereby call the 102<sup>nd</sup> Annual Convention of the American Legion Auxiliary Department of Texas, to meet in the Rio Grande A of the Renaissance Hotel, Austin, Texas.

**PURPOSE**

The Purpose of the of Convention shall be to accept reports of the Department Officers and Committees; to elect Department Officers for the coming year, which includes a Department President, Department Vice President, Department Secretary, Department Chaplain, Department Historian, Department Sgt-at-Arms, and National Executive Committee Person; to confirm the elected Division Presidents, the Presidents and Vice Presidents of the even numbered Districts; to elect delegates and alternates to the National Convention and to transact such other business as may properly come before the Convention.

**DELEGATES**

Unit representation shall be two delegates for the first ten (10) members and one additional delegate for each twenty-five members or major fraction thereof, whose current dues have been received in Department Headquarter two weeks prior to the convening of said Convention, and one alternate for each delegate. The delegates and alternates shall be elected at a Unit meeting duly called for this purpose not less than four weeks prior to the Department Convention. These names shall be mailed and be received at Department Headquarters no later than June 24, 2022.

A Unit registration fee of Ten (\$10.00) dollars shall accompany the list of delegates.

Members of the Department Executive Committee present and voting shall be delegates-at-large to the Department Convention with vote to be exercised with their Units.

Past Department Presidents in good standing in their Units shall be life delegates-at-large to the Department Convention, with vote to be exercised with their Units.

Each delegate shall be entitled to one vote. The vote of any delegate absent and not represented by an alternate shall be cast by the majority of the registered and certified Unit delegates present at the Department Convention.

A quorum shall exist when fifteen (15) percent of the units are represented and have paid their Unit Convention registration fees. (Department Constitution, Article VI, sections 1 through 8).
