PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Cancer Research Program is a Texas based one of a kind program that has partnered with The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center UT Health Houston Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences to advance cancer research through the generous American Legion Auxiliary Fellowship program.

More than \$1.7M has been awarded to nearly two hundred high-achieving doctoral students who are trained by leading biomedical scientists from MD Anderson and UTHealth Houston. Donations to this Fellowship Program are used to uncover new cancer treatments that will save and improve lives.
