

American Legion Auxiliary Website Guidelines

Units are encouraged to set up and maintain Web pages promoting The American Legion Auxiliary, provided they follow a few simple guidelines.

- The person who places a home page on the web supporting and/or promoting The American Legion Auxiliary is responsible for notifying Department of such page's existence and providing the new home page's URL.
- All web pages related to the Sons of The American Legion should contain a link to The American Legion Auxiliary home page at <http://www.alaforveterans.org> and The American Legion Auxiliary Department of Texas home page at <http://www.alatexas.org>).
- It's recommended that home pages contain one or more links to other units' home pages (this is recommended as a courtesy, not a requirement).
- Web pages promoting The American Legion Auxiliary must not contain commercial advertisements or for-profit promotional plugs or links to such pages/sites.
- Web pages related to The American Legion Auxiliary must not contain any nude or pornographic images or otherwise objectionable material or links to pages containing such material.
- The American Legion Auxiliary home pages should contain information pertaining to local, state and/or national programs and projects as well as links to pages that give detailed information on the programs, goals, and ideals of The American Legion Auxiliary.
